# What Are the Travel Markets?

VTrans is establishing Needs for five distinct types of travel markets:

#### **Corridors of Statewide Significance (CoSS)**

» Serve inter-regional travel

#### Regional Networks (RNs)

» Serve commuters, intra-regional, and local travel

# Urban Development Areas (UDAs) and Industrial and Economic Development Areas (IEDAs)

#### UDAs:

- » Designated by local governments
- » Intended to promote walkable development and traditional neighborhood design **IEDAs**:
- Defined as statewide locations of potential industrial development sites
- » Submitted by local governments to Virginia Economic Development Partnership's Business Ready Site Program

#### Safety


» Addresses needs on all roadways, regardless of ownership




